Dear Donor,

My name is P.Srinivasan. I joined Sevalaya when I was seven years old. My father left our family when I was very young and my mother lives on a pavement in north Madras. As she had no proper income, she could not educate me or feed me. She left me at the care of Sevalaya. I stayed in Sevalaya hostel and studied in their school.

Thanks to donors like you, I have now completed B.Sc. Computer science and got selected in campus interview. I will be joining my first job in June 2010. I will start earning and will stand on my own leg and I will support my mother. I will also support one child in Sevalaya, in the next academic year.

Sevalaya is taking care of 1000s of children like me. This year Sevalaya has built a new school building and they will be admitting 500 more children. Hence the school strength is expected to cross 1500

We get two sets of uniforms, note books and all other educational material free of cost from Sevalaya trust. They don't charge us any fee. Thus, on an average, the educational expenses for one child comes to Rs 6000 per year. For 1500 children, the total school expenses comes to Rs 90 lakhs. Just to start the school year, they need atleast Rs 1000 per child, this itself comes to Rs 15 lakhs.

I have got the benefit from donors like you. My family will thank you for generations to come for the support you have given me through Sevalaya trust.


Now there are 1500 children like me, waiting for support. I can support one child only as I am just starting to earn and I have to help my mother. How about you?
